



Rev. Andrew Lee Patton Sr.

Rev. Andrew Lee Patton, Sr. was born on April 9th, 1948 to the late Carrie Patton and Henry Barksdale in Lexington, Mississippi. Rev. Patton married the late Rosie Ann Bowman and they were fruitful in producing five wonderful children: Andrew Lee Patton Jr. (Sherry), Benjamin Patton (Rest In Heaven), Samuel Patton (LaTara), Daniel Patton, and Dorcas Anita Patton-Bolton (Cameron). He was a jack of all trades including carpentry, salesmanship, culinary expertise, and a witty man with words concerning multiple aspects of life, just to name a few. His favorite phrase was simply "Byeeeeeeee", which had many connotations depending on the situation he used it in.

Andrew Lee Patton, Sr. was a father figure to several young men in the South Memphis neighborhood. He was also very influential in his firstborn son's life at a young age to preach the saving Gospel of Jesus Christ and has been a Pastor, street preacher, elder, and associate minister. He was ordained as an Elder under the late presiding Bishop J.O. Patterson, Sr. This was a firm foundation in molding his street ministry. One of his most influential sermons preached was "Use What You've Got", which Rev. Patton's second son Samuel refers to daily throughout his life. His street ministry was the launching pad and foundation that led to Rev. Patton planting the church named "Rose of Sharon"

Rev. Patton was preceded in death by his mother-in-law (Annie Caine), sisters (Earnestine, Mary Elizabeth, and Clarice), and brothers (George, James, Jerry, Albert, Robert, and Garfield). He leaves behind two wonderful brothers-

in-law (Cornelious "Bill" Doty and Reese Bowman), as well as several nieces, nephews, friends, and grandchildren (Ryan, Aubrey, Levi, Mia, Caiden, Genesis, Samuel Lebron, Deylon, Alexandria, Marlon, Tyler, and Bria.) Many of the grandkids can all mimic the famously coined phrase "Byeeeeeeee", even at their young age.

He will be greatly missed but never forgotten. Rev. Patton's name and influence will live on for generations to come.
